### Covenants Corner (A reminder to all):

Section 14. Vehicles. All motor vehicles shall be currently licensed and maintained in a proper operating condition so as not to be a hazard or nuisance by noise, exhaust emissions or appearance. All motor vehicles including trail bikes and motorcycles shall be driven only upon paved streets and driveways. Overnight parking of recreational vehicles and related equipment shall be in garages or screened

enclosures approved by the Architectural Control Committee (HOA) stored in such manner as to not be visible from any street. Includes: junk vehicles, commercial or industrial vehicles, including but not limited to moving vans, trucks, tractors, trailers, wreckers, hearses, compressors, concrete mixers, or buses shall be parked in the street or streets abutting any Lot. No trucks or vans shall be parked outside of any garage at any time. No storage of boating equipment, travel trailers, camping equipment, or recreational vehicles shall be allowed. Section 11. Garbage and Refuse Disposal. Trash and garbage containers **shall not be permitted to remain in public view** except on days of trash collection. Storage of any other items shall be within the confines of the rear yards directly behind the house. No accumulation or storage of litter or trash of any other kind shall be permitted on any lot. ### How do I get a recycling bin or a replacement recycling bin?

Call Advanced Disposal for recycling bins at <u>678-240-9137</u>, you should be able to get the initial bin at no cost. ### **Curbside recycling service:**

- Pickup once per week (Thursdays for our neighborhood)
- Recyclables must be placed curbside the night before, or before 8 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection. (Thursdays for our neighborhood)
- All recyclables must be inside the container for collection.
- Items accepted for pickup include:- Aluminum, steel food and beverage cans, foil, pie tins, brown, green, clear and blue glass bottles and jars, plastic containers #1-7, mixed paper (newspaper, telephone books, magazines, catalogs, office paper, glossy forms & junk mail), cardboard and chipboard, corrugated cardboard.

### Yard waste service:

- Pickup once per week (Thursdays for our neighborhood)
- Yard waste must be placed curbside the night before collection day, or prior to 8 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Yard waste includes weeds, grass, hedge trimmings, leaves, brush, and tree limbs.
- Yard waste must be placed in paper composting sacks or a 50-gallon metal or plastic container.
- Branches and tree limbs must not exceed 4 feet in length, 6 inches in diameter, nor weigh more than 50 pounds.

### **Neighborhood Courtesy:**

When having a party, and at all times, please do not park on both sides of the road as it makes it difficult for other cars and emergency vehicles to get through or blocking the sight distance for other drivers. So, if there is a car already parked on the right side of the road then all cars should be parking on the right side of the road facing the direction of travel. In cul-de-sacs, all cars should be parked next to a curb (only one car deep) and no one's driveway should be blocked unless you have the owner's permission.
